

Supporting people with prescribed anti- embolism stockings and prescribed compression stockings

Anti-embolism stockings are commonly used after surgery to prevent blood clotting by gently compressing the leg. This increases blood flow and prevents the veins expanding which then stops pooling of the blood in the lower leg forming clots.
